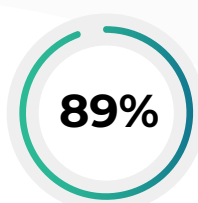
Attendee Seniority level breakdown



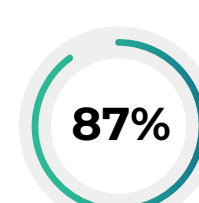

Operational Excellence at Scale: 'Leveraging Exception Management in Remote Oil & Gas Operations'

- Many operators are challenged with high well counts spread over large geographic areas. How can they scale the business while maintaining OPEX?
